UTILITY FAQs

Q: What is the stormwater fee?

A: The stormwater fee is a fee all property owners in the City of Westfield pay to maintain the infrastructure of drainage systems around the city and ensure our community complies with the Federal Clean Water Act (City Ordinance 16-08).

Q: What options do I have for paying my stormwater bill?

A: The stormwater fee is billed by the City of Westfield. You have the following options:

- Mail payment to **PO Box 863 Indianapolis, IN 46206**
- Drop off payment at City Services at **2728 E. 171st St. Westfield, IN 46074** (8 A.M. - 4 P.M. | The building is closed for lunch 12 - 1 P.M.)
- Enroll in ACH to have payments automatically deducted from a checking account on the due date
- Pay online or over the phone with a Visa or MasterCard (**\$2 fee applied**)
- Utilize the 24-hour dropbox at City Services at **2728 E. 171st Street Westfield, IN 46074**

Q: Where do I pay my trash bill?

A: Trash billing is handled directly through Waste Management. To establish service, you can contact them at 866-797-9018 or customerservices_gla@wm.com. WM provides up to three 96-gallon carts for weekly trash and recycling collection - two 96-gallon trash carts and one 96-gallon recycling cart or two 96-gallon recycle carts and one 96-gallon trash cart. **When you sign up for service, you can select your cart configuration.**

Q: Where do you find a list of the do's and don'ts for recycling?

A: Please visit Waste Management's website at: wm.com/us/en/recycle-right

Q: When are collection hours for trash and recycling?

A: Service occurs on a weekly basis between 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. Waste Management requests containers be out before 6:30 A.M. at the end of your driveway. Trash and recycling are serviced on the same day but at different times within the day due to the use of separate trucks.

PUBLIC WORKS FAQs

Q: When will my neighborhood be repaved?

A: Typically, for a public residential street, you can expect roughly 15 to 20 years between major rehabilitation work on the roadway.

Q: I live in a subdivision with a private road. Who replaces that?

A: The neighborhood HOA is responsible for repaving and repairing privately owned roads.

Q: What are those black lines on the roads?

A: Those are a maintenance solution called crack sealing. They help prolong the life of the roadway.

Q: How can I get a pothole repaired?

A: The quickest way to notify the Public Works Department about a pothole is to use the Report It! tool on the city's website. **Scan the QR code for quick access.**

Q: I put in a request to have my sidewalk repaired. Why didn't it get fixed?

A: There are a couple of reasons that could be. It could be a private sidewalk; the city only fixes public sidewalks. If it is a public sidewalk, the city only repairs for trip hazards, not cosmetic issues.

SAFETY RESOURCES



PROJECT LIFESAVER

Project Lifesaver combines state-of-the-art technology with a skilled search and rescue team to help find missing individuals. Those enrolled in the program wear a wristband that sends out a silent radio signal. When a caregiver reports a missing person to 911, a trained search team is dispatched to the area, using advanced tracking equipment. This technology has significantly cut search times from hours or days to mere minutes. To date, more than 3,022 searches have been conducted nationwide, with no reported fatalities or serious injuries, and the typical recovery time is under 30 minutes.

AWARE PROGRAM

AWARE provides a visible 4-inch emblem or sticker that can be placed on vehicles and homes to alert first responders that an individual with a cognitive disorder may be present. Agencies participating in the AWARE program must secure a referral from a medical professional before distributing these emblems to clients. Caregivers can feel reassured knowing that communities and first responders involved in the AWARE initiative are better equipped to engage with their loved ones in a more informed and thoughtful manner.

COMMUNITY CONNECT

Community Connect is a free, secure, and user-friendly platform designed to help you share important information about your household with first responders and emergency personnel. By providing details that you believe are vital in an emergency, we can better protect you and your loved ones, ensuring a more effective and informed response when needed.

To enroll, scan the QR code and choose “Resident” or “Business Owner”, you will be prompted to create a new account if you have not already done so.

CITIZENS ACADEMY

The Citizen’s Academy is an 11-week program for Westfield residents to gain hands-on experience in police work. Participants will tour the county jail, dispatch center, and training facilities, while learning about patrol, investigations, and evidence processing. The program also includes emergency driving, patrol stops, firearms training, defense tactics, taser and K9 demos, and active shooter simulations.

To be eligible, you must fill out an application and pass a background check. Scan the QR code to learn more and access the application.

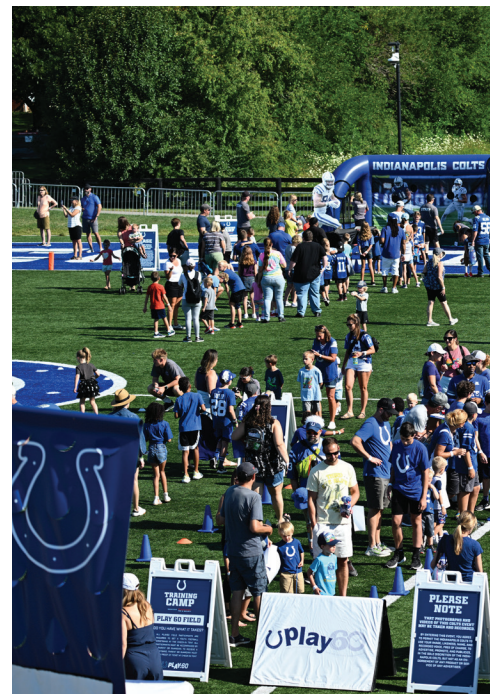
